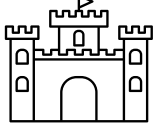


BERKSHIRE

LIFESTYLE AND CULTURE



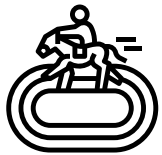
WINDSOR CASTLE

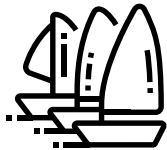
ASCOT RACECOURSE

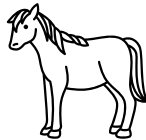
THE RIVER THAMES
