

Professor Phil Dash is the Head of the School of Biological Sciences at the University of Reading and a Professor of Cancer Biology.

He started his career in cancer research at the University of Birmingham where he obtained his PhD before moving to St. George's Hospital in London and then eventually to the University of Reading where he heads up a research group investigating the mechanisms through which cancer spreads. In addition to research he also teaches cell and cancer biology to undergraduate and postgraduate students at the University.

As a member of the Health Innovation Partnership board and co-chair of the University's Health Strategy group he has also helped strengthen relationships between the University and the Royal Berkshire NHS Foundation Trust and in his role as Head of School he has prioritised engagement with employers in the Life Sciences industry to strengthen education and research.
