

Yuan Yang is the Member of Parliament for Earley and Woodley, a new constituency in Reading which also covers Sonning, Shinfield and Whitley. She is an economist by training, and after her master's degree, founded Rethinking Economics, a charity that campaigns to make economics teaching more relevant to the real world.

Before being selected by the Labour Party to stand for Parliament, she spent eight years working as a journalist at the Financial Times, where she was previously FT Europe-China correspondent, and before that their Beijing deputy bureau chief.

In 2024 Yuan published her first book, Private Revolutions, with Bloomsbury (UK) and Penguin Viking (US). The book describes China's economic transformation and the rise and fall of social mobility, told through the coming-of-age stories of four millennial Chinese women.

Since entering Parliament, Yuan has been elected as a member of the Treasury Select Committee and as Chair of the All-Party Parliamentary Group for Social Science and Policy.
