Brendan Vickers is Policy Director at International Chambers of Commerce (ICC) United Kingdom. He is a senior policy leader with more than 20 years of experience in international trade and investment, spanning government, international organisations, business, and policy institutions.

Prior to joining ICC, Brendan served as Head of International Trade Policy at the Commonwealth Secretariat in London, where he supported its 56 member countries in strengthening economic cooperation. Earlier in his career, he was Head of Research and Policy and a lead trade negotiator at South Africa's Department of Trade and Industry, and Deputy Director for International Relations and Trade in the Office of President Thabo Mbeki.
